

Embroidered Buttons Holes

YOU WILL NEED

- *Anchor Stranded Cotton Skeins- 1 skein each of shade nos.47, 56, 59, 160, 239, 245, 298, 309, 332, 360, 401 and Black.*
- *Embroidery Ring*
- *Crewel needle no.7*
- *Buttons (different shapes)*
- *Plain shirt/s as shown in illustration or as desired*

HOW TO DO

Trace the motifs onto the button placket as shown in the illustration or as desired. The motifs could also be used for collars, pockets, etc.



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HOW TO DO

Mount the fabric onto the embroidery ring for the right tension of stitches. The following stitches* are used - Stem Stitch, Satin Stitch, Chain Stitch, Straight Stitch, Herringbone Stitch, Long & Short Stitch, Lazy Daisy Stitch, French Knots. The embroidery is carried out with only 2 strands of thread throughout. Follow the colour illustration, the diagrams and key to diagrams for the placement of colours and stitches.



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HOW TO DO

To Make Up :

On completion of embroidery, dismount the fabric from the embroidery ring and press on the wrong side with a hot iron over a damp cloth.



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
