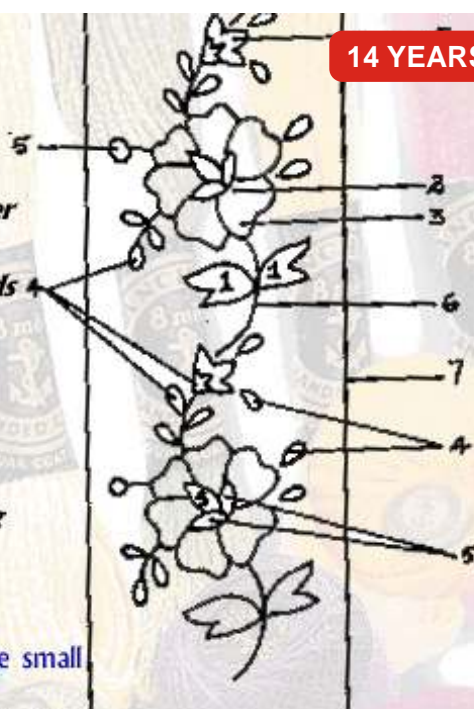

## YOU WILL NEED

- *Anchor Stranded Cotton - 1 skein of shade number 302; 2 skeins each of shade numbers 304 and 386. Use 2 strands throughout.*
- *Crewel needle no.7*
- *1.25 m red/maroon drill/casement fabric*
- *Small strip of velcro - for the spectacle case*
- *1 m lining fabric to match*
- *Zip fasteners - 18 cm long for pouch; 38 cm long for bag*

## HOW TO DO

1. The diagram gives a section of the border design with the small broken lines indicating the position of the first repeat.
2. Trace the required length of the design in position onto the respective pieces and work embroidery following the key to diagram.

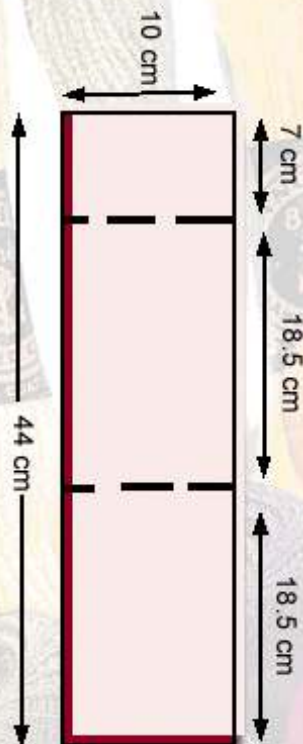

## HOW TO DO

### Spectacle Case -

Follow the layout diagrams and cut out the required number of pieces from the drill/casement and lining fabric for the bag, pouch and spectacle case. Remember to give 1 cm seam allowance while cutting the pieces of fabric.

Attach lining to the wrong side of the embroidered fabric. Fold along the dotted line (refer layout diagram) and sew all three sides leaving the top open.

## HOW TO DO

### Spectacle Case -

Turn to right side. Fold in the top edge and attach velcro to the flap and case correspondingly.

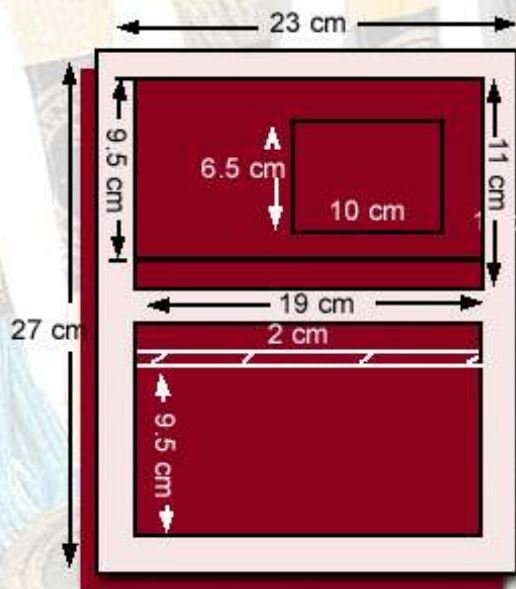

## HOW TO DO

### Pouch -

Attach lining to the wrong side of the embroidered section and related pieces. Fold in the raw edges and fix the 6.5 cm x 10 cm piece to the 9.5 cm x 19 cm piece. Then attach this piece to the 11 cm x 19 cm piece leaving the 19 cm edge open. Then sew this pocket in place onto one half of the pouch. For the second pocket, join the 18 cm zip fastener to the 2 cm x 19 cm and 9.5 cm x 19 cm sections. Sew this pocket onto the other half of the pouch as shown in the layout diagram.

## HOW TO DO

### Pouch -

Attach lining to the wrong side of the embroidered section and related pieces. Fold in the raw edges and fix the 6.5 cm x 10 cm piece to the 9.5 cm x 19 cm piece. Then attach this piece to the 11 cm x 19 cm piece leaving the 19 cm edge open. Then sew this pocket in place onto one half of the pouch. For the second pocket, join the 18 cm zip fastener to the 2 cm x 19 cm and 9.5 cm x 19 cm sections. Sew this pocket onto the other half of the pouch as shown in the layout diagram.

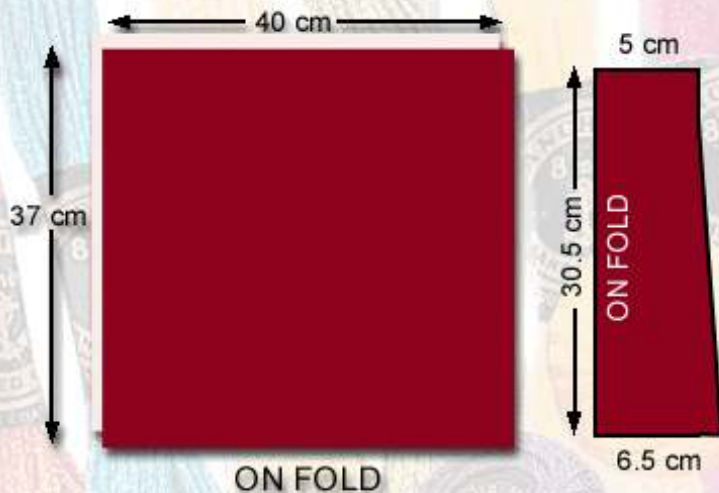

## HOW TO DO

### Bag -

Attach lining fabric to the wrong side of all the sections of the drill fabric. Fold in the raw edges and over-stitch the embroidered borders in position onto the main section of the bag for the handles (refer layout diagram).



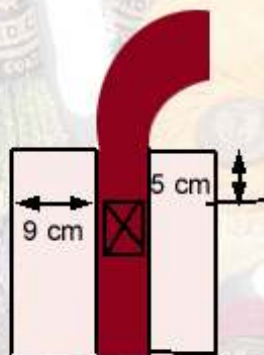
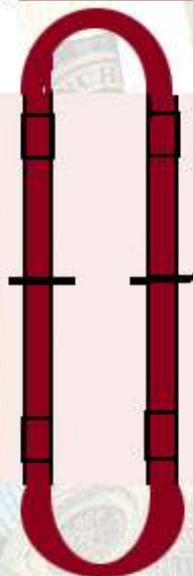
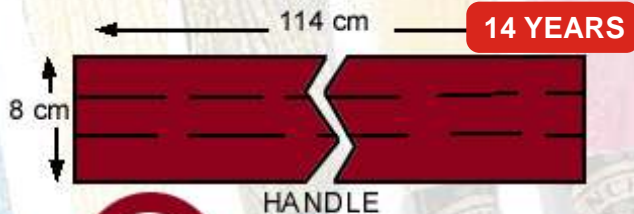

Join the two side panels to the main section of the bag.



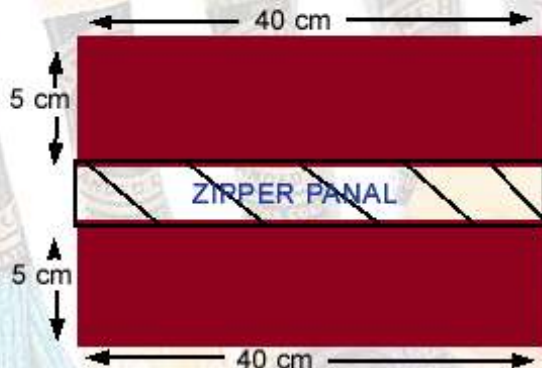
